## About us

The Center of Rehabilitation La Nostra Famiglia of Pisan di Prato has started its activities in 1984.

It is a health facility that works in agreement and accreditation in the Framework of the Regional Health Service. It is aimed at functional recovery of the prevailing subjects mind in developmental age.

It provides diagnose and rehabilitation services, offering multi-disciplinary courses that ensure the subject's overall care.

The service is carried out in an outpatient form in a continuous day cycle. In 1998, it was recognized by an Inter-ministerial Decree as the seat of the Regional Center of the IRCCS (Institute of Hospitalizing and Scientific Care) Eugenio Medea.

The Center of Pisan di Prato is a regional reference center for visual impairment.



## Treated pathologies

The Center deals with the functional diagnosis and rehabilitation of neuro-motor and neuro-psychic pathologies of the developmental age such as:

- infantile cerebral palsy
- outcomes of traumatic brain injury (cranioencephalic trauma outcomes) and expansive lesions of the Central Nervous System
- malformation syndromes
- neuromuscular pathologies
- cognitive disability
- autism spectrum disorders
- complex visual and auditory disturbances
- specific disorders of language, of praxic-motor function, of school learning
- emotional and behavioral disorders at
- psycho pathological risk
- neuropsychological disorders



It also favors the social and scholastic integration of children affected with physical, mental and sensory disabilities.

## Outpatient specialistic services

The Center is accredited for the specialistic outpatient services in the branches of:

- Child Neuropsychiatry
- Ophthalmology
- Physical medicine and rehabilitation (physiatry)

## Outpatient treatment

This service is aimed at individuals in developmental age by providing rehabilitation programs with individual services relating to the following sectors:

### Psychology

Inside the Center, there is a psychology service which, in addition to carry out direct interventions for children and young people, plays a role of counseling families, schools, and operators of the Center to carry out integrated, effective, harmonious coordinated Actions within the process of taking charge. The service can offer processes of individual psychological support paths for children and a psycho-educational counseling for the parents of the children under rehabilitation.

### Physiotherapy

It is movement therapy that works on the Patient's pathological signs, to remove or reduce them through specific techniques of passive and active mobilization. The intervention is always personalized.

### Hydrokinesitherapy

Included in the field of physiotherapy, it is based on treatment techniques in heated water, both for orthopedic and neurological Diseases, both acute and chronic.



## Neuropsychomotricity of the developmental age

In psychomotor practice, the person is considered in a "global" way, ie as an integration between motor skills (voluntary and involuntary) and psychic activity (affective and cognitive). The therapeutic relationship uses the body and plays as privileged tools; through verbal, non-verbal communication and body mediation techniques, it aims to favor the integration between the Divergent expressive and cognitive levels (motor, affective, cognitive) that are at the basis of the construction of identity.

### Speech therapy

The speech therapy intervention aims at strengthening and recovering problems inherent to the developmental age such as: phono-articulatory disorders, specific and non-specific language disorders, language disorders related to neurosensory hearing loss, specific learning disorders (dyslexia, dysorthography) and non-specific (related to borderline cognitive status or mental insufficiency), stuttering, dysarthria, dysphagia. It increases communicative intentionality, takes care of the acquisition and understanding of oral and written language, both from a formal and functional point of view.





### **Neuro-visual Rehabilitation**

The visual function is a complex circuit in which perceptual, praxic and cognitive phenomena take part. Where there are visual reductions, difficulties in maintaining attention, organizing eye movements and recognizing space and objects, neuro-visual rehabilitation intervenes.

### **Neuropsychological rehabilitation**

A treatment favors the harmonizing of knowledge and cognitive skills and the amount of independence in their use. Increase problem solving strategies and the scheduling for the execution of a task.

### **Occupational therapy**

The rehabilitation sector aims to acquire the ability to independently plan and carry out practical activities of daily life, personal, domestic and social ones. Starting from the analysis of the residual abilities of the patient (motor, cognitive, operational, and social), Occupational Therapy aims at making him reach the best possible functional level in self-care, in the autonomy of travel, in free time activities and at work, both through interventions to enhance the various functions and through the identification of facilitating tools (orthoses and aids and Adaptations of the living environment).

### **Psychoeducational Treatment**

The psycho-educational treatment is inspired by the principles of the Teacch philosophy (autonomy and independence, flexibility of thought, individualization of the intervention, collaboration with family, schools and local Services). It was born mainly as a sector dedicated to subjects with autism spectrum disorders, behavior and communication Problems, socio-relational difficulties.

## **School and social integration**

Children who are certificated according to the Law 104/92 are offered a school and social support intervention through meetings with family members and local schools, this intervention is aimed at monitoring school placement and providing specific guidelines. During these meetings, it is also possible to carry out the drafting of the dynamic functional profile and collaborate in the clarification of the individualized educational plan.

## Continuous day time service

The day service welcomes children who have complex neuropsychiatric profiles for which an intense and global intervention is required. In addition to the rehabilitation treatments, children carry out an individualized educational and didactic path, guaranteed by the presence of specialized teachers and professional educators. The following projects are present:

### Psycho-educational projects for preschoolers

The subjects aged between 3 and 7 years, are managed in small groups by educators who guarantee continuity in didactic activities, Socialization, educational activities and autonomy (lunch and personal hygiene).

### State primary school with particular purposes

The subjects are aged between 6 and 15 years moreover, in addition to the overall taking charge of the rehabilitation facility, they are enrolled in the state primary school regulated by an agreement between the Regional School Office of Friuli Venezia Giulia - Regional Directorate and the Association La Nostra Famiglia. The sections are made up according to the complexity of the users. The school staff, which depends on the Management of the Comprehensive Institute of Pasian di Prato, collaborates with the multidisciplinary team of the center for

the drafting of an individualized educational rehabilitation plan.



## Swimming pool

At the Center, there is a therapeutic pool suitable for rehabilitation services for the developmental age (children). The pool is also open to adults and is designed for both acute and chronic orthopedic and neurological diseases. Physiotherapists and swimming instructors work there.

## Volunteering

Volunteers are a fundamental component of the activities with children and young people, they support the operators who are responsible for educational projects. The Center welcomes requests for volunteering by providing, after an appropriate valuation and training, the regularization of volunteers at the Don Luigi Monza Association.





## Team

Collaborating in the service: doctors (neuropsychiatrists, psychiatrists, neurologists, ophthalmologists), graduate technicians (psychologists, neuropsychologists, social workers, computer engineers), rehabilitation staff (physiotherapists, speech therapists, occupational therapists, neuro-psycho-motricists, orthoptists, professional educators), nurses and social health workers.

## Access mode

Parents or tutors of the children can have access to the first specialist visit by Calling the secretariat of the Center for booking or by contacting the regional single center, which answers on 0434, 22 35 22: in both cases, it is necessary to be already in possession of the referral from the attending physician stating the reason for the visit.

At the time of the first visit it is necessary to have:

- Referral of the attending physician giving the reason for the visit
- HEALTH INSURANCE CARD
- FISCAL CODE

The first visit can also be provided under a solvency regime.

The Mission of Our Family is the care rehabilitation and education of people with Disabilities. The Association is aimed primarily at children and young people. It intends to take charge not only of disability, but also of personal and family suffering. Respect for life, global care, high professionalism, hospitality style are the qualifying aspects of its services, with the aim of promoting the human and spiritual growth of people, social inclusion, and an optimal quality of life. The Association believes that scientific research in the field of developmental pathologies and the training of operators are essential areas of Expression of its mission, as well as attention to countries where the culture of rehabilitation is still in its infancy.

It currently has an extensive network of rehabilitation facilities: it is present in 6 Italian regions.

### Fields of intervention

**Rehabilitation** of people with disabilities, with particular attention also to their education, training and professional training, to the guidance of their families and to their social integration.

**Scientific research** through the activity of the IRCCS Eugenio Medea in the offices of Bosisio Parini (Le), Conegliano (Tv), Pieve di Soligo (Tv), San Vito al Tagliamento (Pn), Piasan di Prato (Ud), Brindisi.

**Training** and updating of personnel services Operators, through the management of degree courses in agreement with universities, higher and professional training, continuous training and the organization of courses and conferences. The offices of the Association are also open to the experiences of Alternanza Scuola Lavoro school- job placement to favor the professional orientation and job placement of young people.

**Reception** of children and adolescents with serious family problems. Reception of adults with disabilities in **residential structures**. Management of **day centers** for people with disabilities.

### Whom it may concern

The quality of the rehabilitation project is guaranteed by high levels of

personalization, professionalism, humanity and science, favoring the integration of the person with disabilities in the community in which they live.

For the Centers of La Nostra Famiglia can have access:

- children who, due to a pathological event that occurred before, during or after birth, have suffered delays, arrests or in any case impairments in their motor, physical or psycho - mental development;
- children or adolescents who, for various reasons, have difficulties in the affective-emotional sphere, in learning and in behavior;
- adults with congenital or acquired
- disabilities for targeted rehabilitation,
- training and assistance projects;
- parents, educators and teachers who wish to have advice or referrals from specialists in the field of child and adolescent developmental, learning and behavioral difficulties.

### Associated entities

- **Associazione di volontariato "don Luigi Monza" [don Luigi Monza voluntary Association]**: it proposes of solidarity and social utility in particular at the Centers of La Nostra Famiglia.
- **OVCI - La Nostra Famiglia [Voluntary organization for International Cooperation La Nostra Famiglia]**: it is a non-governmental body present in Sudan, South Sudan, Brazil, Ecuador, China and Morocco;
- **l'Associazione Sportiva Dilettantistica "Viribus Unitis" [Viribus Unitis Amateur Sports Association]**: promotes the integration of people with disabilities through sport.
